**Worship Aids/Sermon Notes**

Sermon: "PROMISE and COVENANT"

**Scripture Readings:**

**Genesis 2:1-9**

2<sup>1</sup> Thus the heavens and the earth were completed in all their vast array. 2<sup>2</sup> By the seventh day God had finished the work he had been doing; so on the seventh day he rested from all his work. 3<sup>3</sup> Then God blessed the seventh day and made it holy, because on it he rested from all the work of creating that he had done. 4<sup>4</sup> This is the account of the heavens and the earth when they were created, when the LORD God made the earth and the heavens. 5<sup>5</sup> Now no shrub had yet appeared on the earth and no plant had yet sprung up, for the LORD God had not sent rain on the earth and there was no one to work the ground, 6<sup>6</sup> but streams came up from the earth and watered the whole surface of the ground. 7<sup>7</sup> Then the LORD God formed a man from the dust of the ground and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life, and the man became a living being. 8<sup>8</sup> Now the LORD God had planted a garden in the east, in Eden; and there he put the man he had formed. 9<sup>9</sup> The LORD God made all kinds of trees grow out of the ground—trees that were pleasing to the eye and good for food. In the middle of the garden were the tree of life and the tree of the knowledge of good and evil.

**Genesis 2:15-17**

15<sup>15</sup> The LORD God took the man and put him in the Garden of Eden to work it and take care of it. 16<sup>16</sup> And the LORD God commanded the man, "You are free to eat from any tree in the garden; 17<sup>17</sup> but you must not eat from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, for when you eat from it you will certainly die."

**Genesis 3:1-10**

3<sup>1</sup> Now the serpent was more crafty than any of the wild animals the Lord God had made. He said to the woman, "Did God really say, 'You must not eat from any tree in the garden?'" 2<sup>2</sup> The woman said to the serpent, "We may eat fruit from the trees in the garden, 3<sup>3</sup> but God did say, 'You must not eat fruit from the tree that is in the middle of the garden, and you must not touch it, or you will die.'" 4<sup>4</sup> "You will not certainly die," the serpent said to the woman. 5<sup>5</sup> "For God knows that when you eat from it your eyes will be opened, and you will be like God, knowing good and evil." 6<sup>6</sup> When the woman saw that the fruit of the tree was good for food and pleasing to the eye, and also desirable for gaining wisdom, she took some and ate it. She also gave some to her husband, who was with her, and he ate it. 7<sup>7</sup> Then the eyes of both of them were opened, and they realized they were naked; so they sewed fig leaves together and made coverings for themselves. 8<sup>8</sup> Then the man and his wife heard the sound of the LORD God as he was walking in the garden in the cool of the day, and they hid from the LORD God among the trees of the garden. 9<sup>9</sup> But the LORD God called to the man, "Where are you?" 10<sup>10</sup> He answered, "I heard you in the garden, and I was afraid because I was naked; so I hid."
