Red Cross Blood Drive, May 16

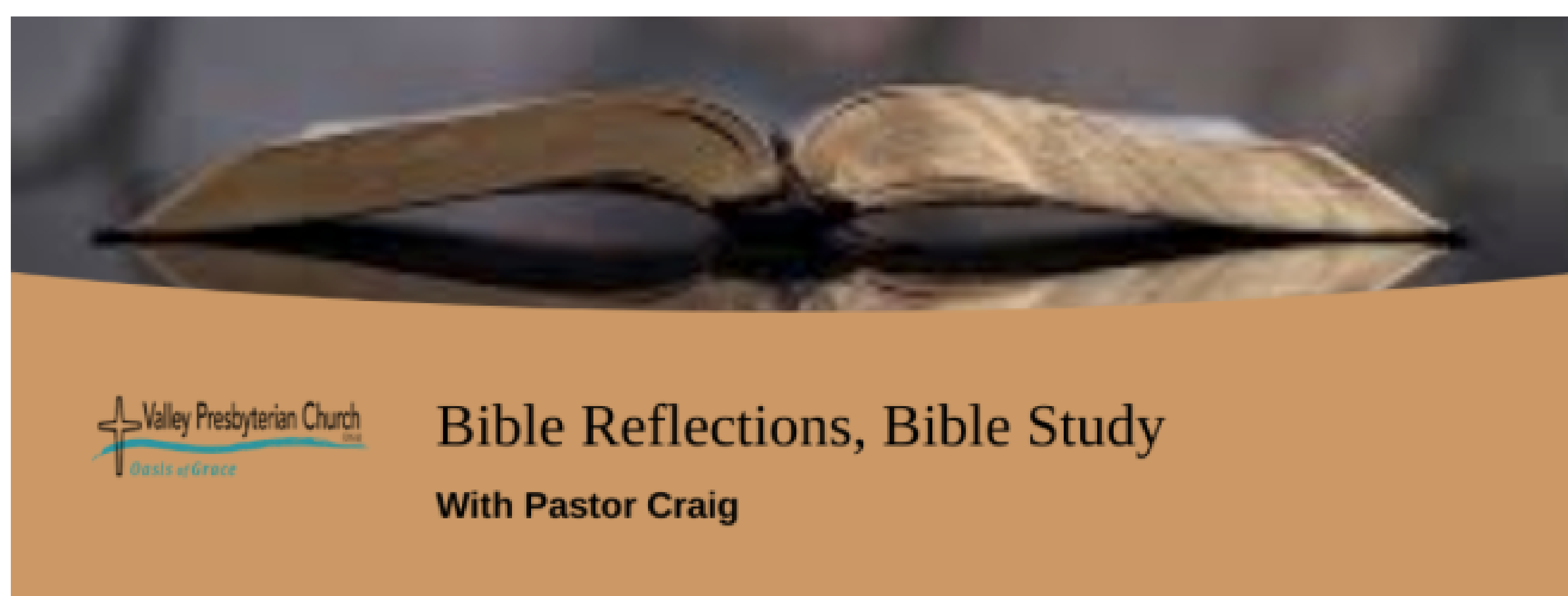
