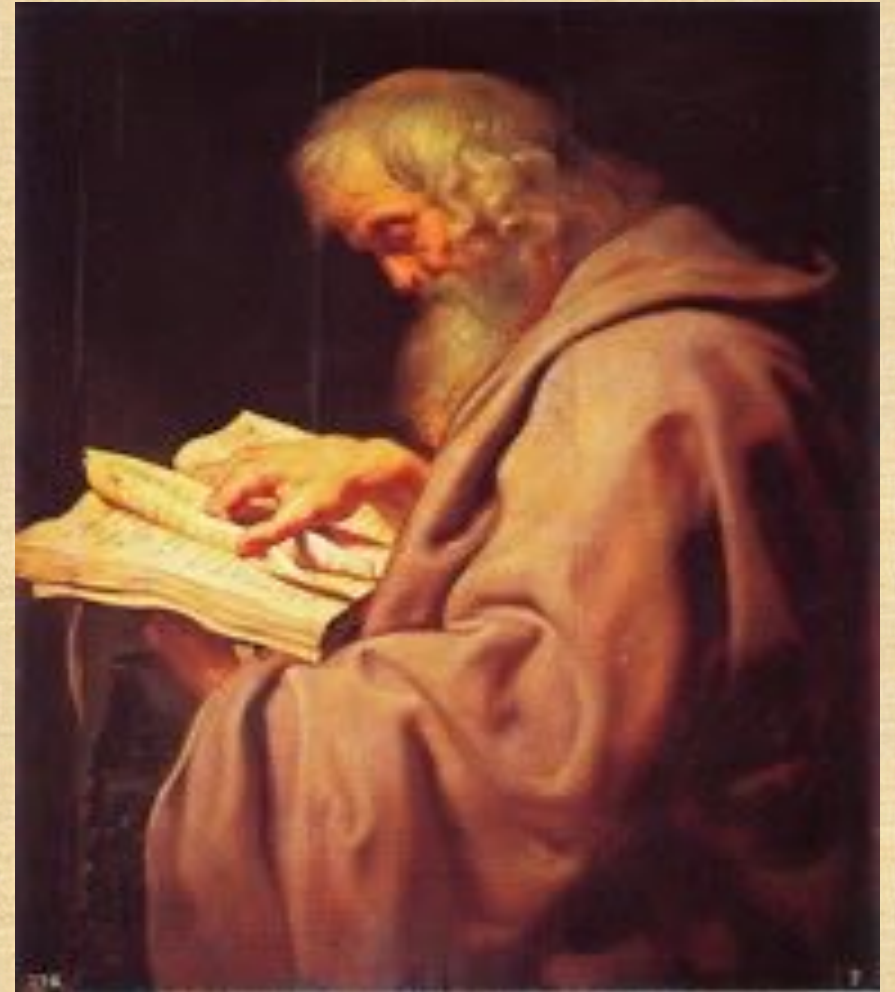




# The Books of Jude and Revelation

**The opening verses of the book give us the name and the author of the book- Jude. He identifies as a brother of James and therefore perhaps a brother of Jesus.**





- **Key term is “contend”**
- **Key verse is verse 3 and 4.**

Jude 3



Jude was written in the AD 60's. His only purpose was to warn believers about false teachers. The false teachers and their teachings are unknown to us in the modern age.

One sentence summary:

*“Christians must defend the faith against false teachings and false teachers, and at the same time they must build up their own faith in Christ.”*

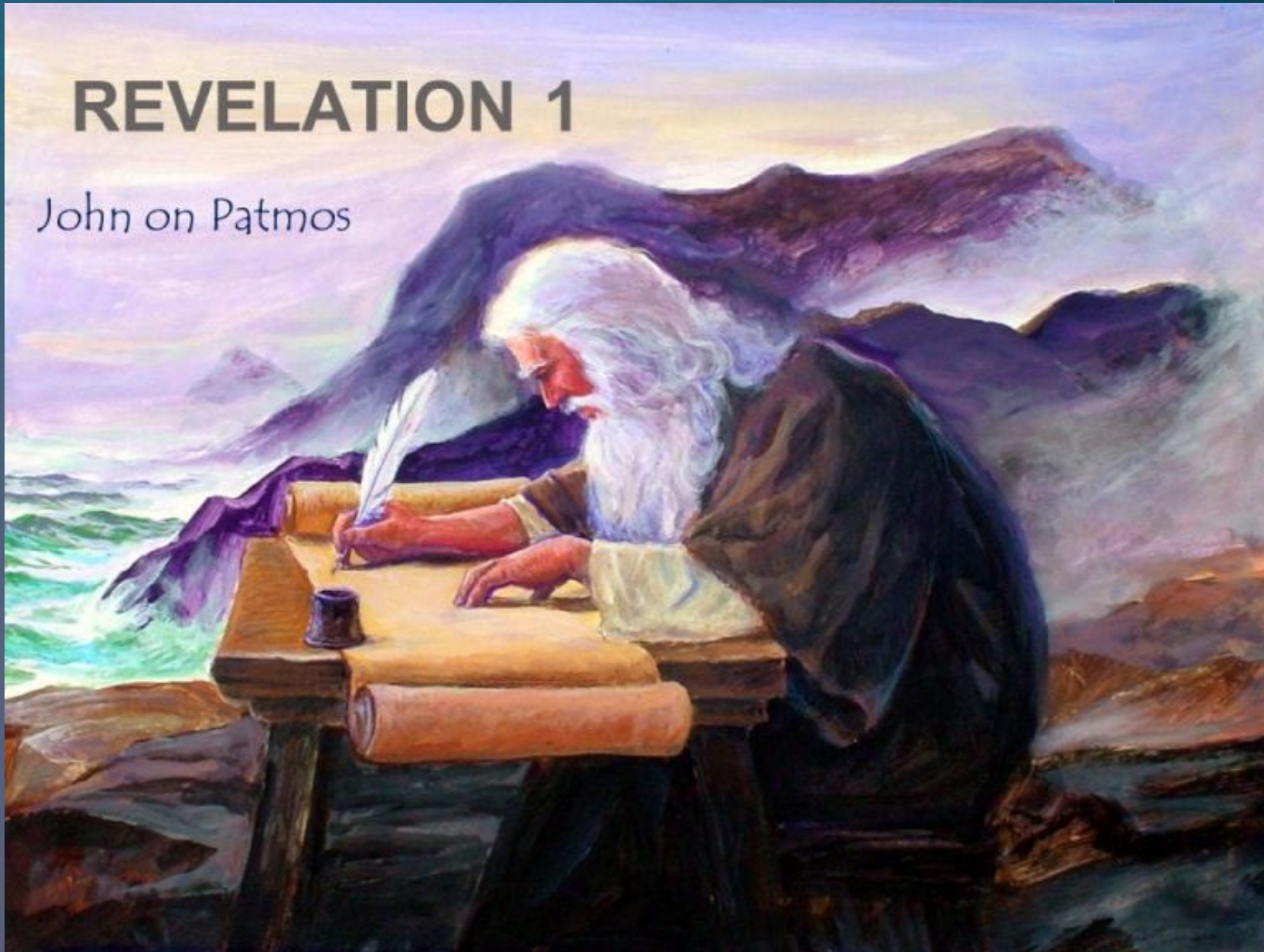

John on Patmos





Just the facts, please!

Written by the Apostle John in about 96AD.

Written on the prison island of Patmos.

The only New Testament book that is essentially prophetic and apocalyptic.



**Key verse is (1:7):**

**“Look, he is coming with  
the clouds,”  
and “every eye will see  
him,  
even those who pierced  
him”;  
and all peoples on  
earth “will  
mourn because of him.”  
So shall it be! Amen.**

- **The one-sentence summary :**

- *Jesus, the Living Lord of history, will return to earth, destroy all evil and opposition to Him, and bring the kingdom of God to its glorious culmination and save the faithful in His heavenly kingdom.*

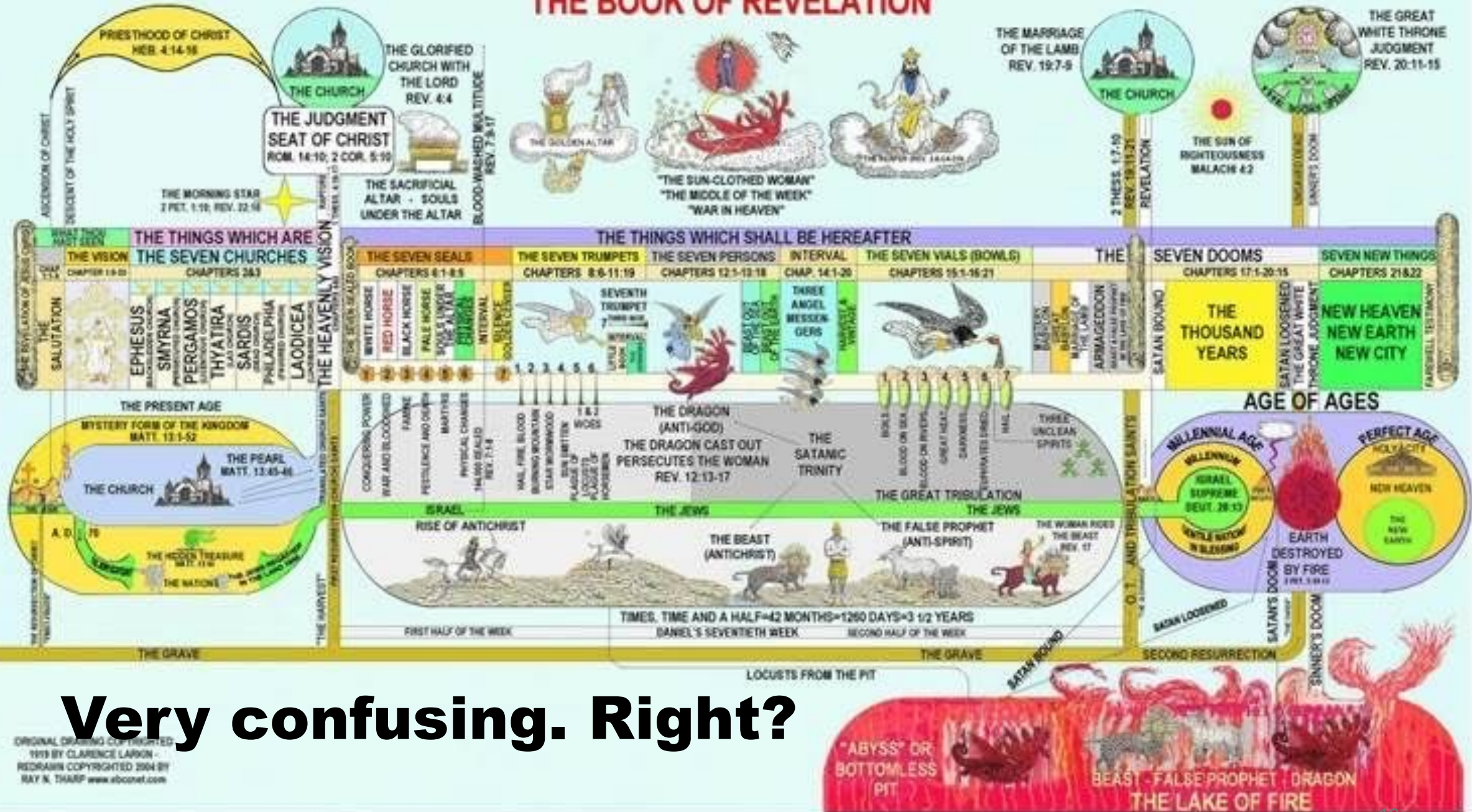


**Revelation was an apocalyptic book, so it had these characteristics:**

- 1) Professed secret information**
- 2) Symbols that only insiders would know**
- 3) It viewed this world from the perspective of heaven**
- 4) Divided history into periods**
- 5) In the story, the darkest moments happen just before the climax of the story.**
- 6) At the end, the forces of good and evil fight with good being victorious.**
- 7) There is a judgement Day.**
- 8) There is a sense that these cataclysmic events will happen soon.**

There occurs all kinds of  
“sevens” in Revelation:

- Seven Churches (Chap. 2 & 3)
- Seven seals (Chap. 5 & 6)
- Seven trumpets (Chap. 8 & 9)
- Seven bowl judgements (Chap 16)



## Introduction in Chapter 1:1-8:

- Written to the seven churches in Asia Minor (Now Turkey)
- These churches were Ephesus, Smyrna, Pergamum, Thyatira, Sardis, Philadelphia and Laodicea. Various issues addressed.
- Commanded by Jesus to write what he saw and send it.
- Seven Golden Lampstands represent these churches.





- ***The first four seals are the ‘Four Horsemen of the Apocalypse’(Rev.6):***

- **A white horse with rider representing conquering power.**
- **A red horse representing bloody war.**
- **A black horse with rider symbolizing famine.**
- **A pale green horse with symbolizing death with Hades as his pageboy.**











# Revelation 8:2



*Next, in chapter 8 more intense troubles for the evil are heralded from trumpets.*

- **First Trumpet:** Hail, fire, and blood will rain down on the earth and wipe out one-third of all plant life.
- **Second Trumpet:** A burning mountain falls into the sea, turns one-third of the ocean to blood.
- **Third Trumpet:** A great star falls from heaven, poisoning one-third of the rivers and springs.
- **Fourth Trumpet:** One-third of the sun, moon, and stars are darkened.
- **Fifth Trumpet:** A star falls from heaven and opens the bottomless pit, releasing smoke and locusts that torment people for five months.

into captivity they will go.


If anyone is to be killed with the sword,

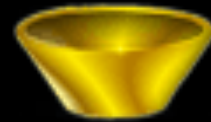
4<sup>th</sup>
